e) Levy for non-return of notice...\$10.00. Motion Carried.

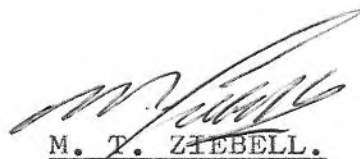

There was no business arising from the Minutes.

BALANCE SHEET: The audited balance sheet was presented by the Club Treasurer, M. Ziebell and moved for acceptance by S. Middleton and seconded by J. Morgan. The accumulated surplus for the 1986/87 year increased by \$787.00 to a total of \$2265.00.

All Members being in favour.

There was no business arising from the Balance Sheet.

CORRESPONDENCE:

1) We received a letter from the 'Kingsford-Smith' Beef-steak and Burgundy Club of Brisbane setting out their years work events for 1988, Expo Year, which also advised that any visitors would be welcome to attend their functions.

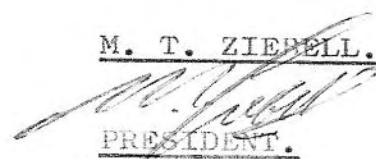

Gentlemen,

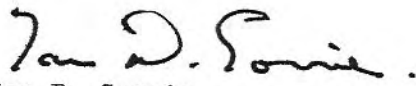
